Jobs and Skills Centres in TAFE Colleges to Replace Careers Centre

On Monday 16 April five Jobs and Skills Centres will open at TAFE campuses across metropolitan Perth replacing the central Careers Centre in Forrest Place. The current services will no longer be available from 4:30pm on Thursday 29 March. The five locations are:

Joondalup Campus – North Metropolitan TAFE
 Balga Campus – North Metropolitan TAFE
 Northbridge Campus – North Metropolitan TAFE
 Rockingham Campus – South Metropolitan TAFE
 Thornlie Campus – South Metropolitan TAFE

Regional Jobs and Skills Centres will open progressively in 2018/19. In the meantime, the Department continues to fund a range of contracted Career Centre services and Aboriginal Workforce Development Centre services.
