Dear Music Students and Parents,

The Trinity Music Department will present the annual Quarry Concert showcasing our Senior Ensembles on Sunday, 30th March 2025. This is an outdoor event in a beautiful venue, The Quarry Amphitheatre, where patrons can bring a picnic dinner to eat prior to the concert.

The following senior ensembles will perform at this concert:

Trinity/Mercedes Wind Orchestra, Trinity/Mercedes String Orchestra, Senior Chorale, Trinity/Mercedes Chorale, Senior Vocal Ensemble, Mercedes Select Choir, Swing Band I, Trinity/Mercedes Classical Guitar Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble I and Trinity/Mercedes Symphonic Brass Ensemble.

The Pipes and Drums Band, String Quartet I, Flute Ensemble, Clarinet Ensemble and No Clu Rock Band will perform as part of the pre-show from 5:00pm – 6:00pm.

Please note that due to the number of students performing in this concert an initial limit of 2 tickets per family has been set for the first ticket release. These tickets must be pre-purchased through Humanitix using the below link. This event will be active online from Friday 7th March until Wednesday 19th March. A second release of tickets will occur on Thursday 20th March until sold out. The second release will provide all families the opportunity to purchase additional tickets.
